We write in strong support of the application submitted by the Rhode Island Department of Transportation (RIDOT) under the FY18 Consolidated Rail Infrastructure and Safety Improvements (CRISI) grant program to further the development of Intercity Amtrak Rail Service at T.F. Green Airport in Warwick, Rhode Island.

In 2017, the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) completed a feasibility study for intercity rail service to T.F. Green Airport.
